Eligibility

- c) Not a current employee of American United Federal Credit Union.
- d) Must be a member of American United Federal Credit Union

Procedures

- a) Complete the Scholarship Application at www.amucu.org/scholarship
- b) Write an essay (300 words or less) that focuses on why you feel you are deserving of this scholarship, your field of study, and long term education/career goals.
- c) Provide an official admittance letter from an accredited secondary college/university, vocational or technical school.
- d) After the deadline, all applications that have met all requirements will be sent to the Scholarship Committee (Resource Committee) for a blind selection process. Once the winner has been selected, they will be notified.

ONLY those applications that have submitted all required items by the date listed will be considered by the Scholarship Committee.
